PIANO SOLO – STUDIES

Own choice. Performers may enter only ONE class in this section. Selections are made from the current RCM or CC Syllabi.

Table with 3 columns: ID (PSINTRO-PS10), Description (Piano Study intro, Prep A or Prep B to Piano Study Grade 10), and Fee (\$10.00 to \$14.00). Includes a note: \*please Indicate prep A or B on Appl.

PIANO SOLO - CONCERT GROUP

Own choice. A concert group consists of a variety of selections from the Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and/or Contemporary periods. Each selection is to be chosen from a different musical period. Competitors will be judged on the discrimination shown in their selections and on the program arrangement with regard to contrast, appropriateness, keys, etc. Competitors must be working at the specified level but may play one piece from a grade that is one higher or one lower than that level.

Table with 4 columns: ID (PC9-PCO), Description (Piano Concert Group Grade 9, 10, Open), Selections (3 selections), and Fee (\$20.00).

PIANO SOLO – POP SELECTION

Own choice. Performers may enter only ONE class in this section. Selections are to be made from the RCM Popular Selection List and must be from the specified edition.

Table with 3 columns: ID (PPS3-PPS9), Description (Piano Pop Selection Grade 3-9), and Fee (\$10.00 to \$14.00).

PIANO SOLO – OTHER REPERTOIRE

Own choice. Selections may not be made from the current RCM or CC syllabi or the RCM Popular Selection List. This class can include music selections from other teaching methods. ie Faber & Faber, Bastien, Music Tree, Celebrate Piano! etc. You may enter more than once in these classes. Performers applying for levels Primer, 1 and 2 do not need to indicate title of piece, but must still indicate duration of piece.
